

## Football Squares – How They Work

- 1) Start with a blank 10 by 10 board of numbered squares. The reason for the 10 by 10 board is to cover all possible numbers for the football game score by using numbers 0 through 9.
- 2) Sell each square for \$20 per square. Each square can be sold to one person or a group of 2 or more who might want to join in to split the cost. Any payouts won will be given to one primary contact per square. It is their responsibility to divide to the group.
- 3) Once all 100 squares have been sold and have names in them, 10 random drawings for each number 0 through 9 are pulled for the gray boxes below Chicago Bears and the gray boxes to the right of Detroit Lions. For our tournament, we will video the drawing of each number and post to social media. The final draw of the squares will also be posted prior to the game so everyone can see what numbers they drew for the football game.
- 4) Payouts for the game are as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter football score - \$200
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter football score - \$250
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter football score - \$300
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter football score - \$350
  - There are no payouts for overtime score.
- 5) Wait for the game!

How to determine winners:

Below is an example squares board with numbers drawn for each team in the GRAY boxes. Also, instead of names in the white numbered squares, I've left the square numbers to explain which square(s) are the winners based on an example game score by quarter below.

Example for Game Score by end of each quarter				
	End of Quarter 1	End of Quarter 2	End of Quarter 3	End of Quarter 4
Example - Team 1	14	21	28	35
Example - Team 2	7	10	13	21

Winners are determined by the last digit of each team's score at the end of each quarter. Using the Example above, the winners are:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Winner = Square 81 based on last digit (Team 1 = 4, Team 2 = 7)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Winner = Square 76 based on last digit (Team 1 = 1, Team 2 = 0)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Winner = Square 59 based on last digit (Team 1 = 8, Team 2 = 3)
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Winner = Square 15 based on last digit (Team 1 = 5, Team 2 = 1)
